

Terms and Conditions for participation in the Arctic Frontiers Student Forum (AFSF) Program 2026

Insurance

It is a requirement to have travel and health insurance to attend the AFSF. Citizens of the EU/EEA countries have the same right to healthcare as Norwegian citizens in Norway. Remember to bring your European Health Insurance Card along with your passport if you travel from abroad.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that the participant withdraws from the AFSF after travel and accommodation have been booked and confirmed, and in the case that no refund is possible, the participant can be held responsible for paying the full costs of the AFSF and travel.

In the event that the AFSF cannot be held or is postponed due to events beyond the control of the AFSF organizers (force majeure) or due to events which are not attributable to wrongful intent or gross negligence of the AFSF organizers, the AFSF organizers cannot be held liable by delegates for any damages, costs, or losses incurred, such as transportation costs, accommodation costs, financial losses, etc. Under these circumstances, the AFSF organizers reserve the right to reimburse the participants after deducting costs already incurred for the organisation of the AFSF and which could not be recovered from third parties.

Participation – Pre-conference webinars and conference program

Interest in the AFSF program is high and a waiting list will be created. The AFSF organizers underline that participation in the pre-conference webinars is mandatory. Lack of communication of non-attendance for these mandatory webinars can lead to your place being given to someone on the waiting list. Should you have a valid reason for not being able to participate, please contact the AFSF Program coordinator (see below).

There are mandatory aspects of the conference week programme, which will be communicated to successful applicants. It is expected that all AFSF2026 participants will attend mandatory aspects, unless a valid reason is provided.
